

## **Liberty High School Instrumental Music Boosters Meeting Minutes August 8, 2006**

### **Secretary's Report (Sharon McDowell)**

- We ended up making \$4,357.71 at the funnel cake stand in June.
- We made a motion to pay back the Harkins for the milk they bought for the funnel cake batter even though the receipt was misplaced . The motion was unanimously accepted.

### **Old/New Business (Rochelle Schneiderman)**

- Six bands thus far have signed up to attend the Extravaganza.
- The band directors and judges will have a buffet set up for them in the cafeteria. James Anastasion will take care of this.
- We have no exhibition band yet. All the bands that have been contacted have other obligations but we will continue to seek one.
- Pam Sorensen is taking over the spirit wear sales. We discussed what items to sell as well as prices to charge. An order form will go into the next school newsletter and Mr. Piper said he would put a link on the school web-site. Also, Pam said she would set up a table with order forms at the preview show/tailgate party as well as the back to school open houses.

- Rochelle got an e-mail from Ginger Halvorsen requesting a volunteer from each booster organization to take the training to become a volunteer trainer. Each organization can then train their own volunteers and relieve her from doing it all. Sharon McDowell volunteered to do this.
- Mary Llewellyn brought an entertainment book for us to look at as a possible fundraiser. The cost is \$25 a book and we will earn \$12.50. We agreed to go with the book and sale dates will be Sept. 25<sup>th</sup> – Oct. 5<sup>th</sup>. It was decided not to sell the candles this year though because of dwindling interest and a small profit margin.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:00. The date for the Sept. meeting has yet to be decided because the school will be closed on our regular meeting day. A notice will be sent out when we get a date.
