Secretary's Report (Sharon McDowell)

Instrumental Music Director's Report (Brandi Jason)

- The orchestra received all 2's at the district festival. The wind ensemble received all 1's so they will be attending the state festival at Morgan State University.
- Congratulations go out to the indoor guard for receiving many 1st and 2nd place awards during their competition season.
- There are 77 or 78 students going on the spring trip to Hershey Park.
- The Jazz band will not be going to the Apple Blossom Festival due to it being senior switch day and the prom being the next day.
- Repairs have been done on all instruments that needed it.
- The Pop's concert flyer has been printed up and tickets are being printed.

Treasurer's Report (Barbara Rooney)

- Barbara provided each attendee with a copy of the current budget report.
- Sheldon Bair, who came and helped the wind ensemble prepare for district festival, will be paid from the miscellaneous director's fund.

Old/New Business (Rochelle Schneiderman)

- Jim Mullen has sent out 50 invitations thus far for next year's Extravaganza. It was suggested he check out the TOB and Blue Wave websites to get a listing of all the bands that participated and send invitations to those bands that he hasn't already contacted. We still need to find someone to run the food concession next year also.

- The Pop's concert will be on April 14th in the school auditorium with free refreshments that we will provide during intermission in the lobby. Students will make up baskets to raffle off.
- Mary Llewellyn has the permit number for the bingo and all the Vera Bradley bags have been purchased. 300 tickets have been printed. We will have one 50/50 raffle during the night and Pam Sorensen said she would be in charge of that. Barbara Rooney will be in charge of the money and ticket sales. Donna Cromer is in charge of student helpers. Lorrie Brown will run the food concession with the assistance of Sharon McDowell. Rochelle Schneiderman will work as a ticket taker or wherever needed. Everyone working needs to be there by 4:30 to help set up. Ms. Jason will be asking the students to donate \$10 each to help sponsor a bag (6 music sections will sponsor 1 bag each). Parents will also be asked to sponsor a bag. Advertisements, flyers and ticket sales will start in April. We will also sell tickets a half hour before our next booster meeting in the band room.
- Information for senior scholarships will be coming out in April. All instrumental music students may apply.
- The annual banquet will be held on May 24th at the Sykesville fire hall.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:00. The date for the next meeting is April 10th at 7:00 PM in the band room.
