

Liberty High School Instrumental Music Boosters Meeting Minutes October 10, 2006

President Rochelle Schneiderman called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Each attendee was given a copy of the meeting agenda.

Secretary's Report (Sharon McDowell)

- There was no September booster meeting, so there were no minutes to report.

Instrumental Music Director's Report (Brandi Jason)

- Brandi would like to have the Pops's concert again in February but off school grounds – possibly at the Sykesville Fire Hall. It also would be nice to have a guest performer (group or individual) in addition to the students.

Treasurer's Report (Barbara Rooney)

- Barbara provided each attendee with a copy of the current budget report.
- She also handed out an Extravaganza update and we netted almost \$3000.

Old/New Business (Rochelle Schneiderman)

- The craft fair is coming up on Nov. 18th. We need to get a parent contact list to use to sign up volunteers. Also, a volunteer sign-up page will be put on the band web-site with a notice in the school's newsletter and daily announcements directing people to check it and sign up for the positions listed. We decided to have a meeting just concerning the craft fair on Oct. 25th.
- We are still looking for someone who would be willing to write up articles to submit to the local newspapers.
- We tried but were unsuccessful with coming up with a date yet for the spring Pop's concert (too many conflicts). If we can't secure an off campus venue, would prefer to have it in the school gym again only if we could get some tables and chairs. Barbara Rooney said that her husband, Bill, might be able to help us with that and she will check with him and get back to us.
- Mary Llewellyn updated us on the "Kid-Stuff" coupon book sale. To date, she has only received payment for 56 books but will extend the sale a few days longer to see if she can get payment for a few more.
- Mary also checked in to the Martin's grocery store gift card fundraiser that Charlie Heaps told us about. This is where we purchase gift cards (\$500 minimum to start) at a 5% discount but sell them at face value to people to use to purchase their groceries.

This could hopefully be an on going fundraiser but if approved, we would need to come up with a regular day and time to distribute them.

- Pam Sorensen requested that she be able to order some extra Liberty T-shirts, etc. to have on hand to sell at various school events. A motion was made to let her buy the additional items and it was unanimously accepted.
- We need to come up with a date for next year's Extravaganza, preferably a little later in the season than the last two. Jim Mullen has offered to take over the Extravaganza next year if he gets some help.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:00. The date for the next meeting will be on November 14th at 7:00 PM in the band room.
